


1. If you already have Cisco AnyConnect installed, skip to step 5. Otherwise, open the following link in your web browser: myaccess.calu.edu
2. Choose Student from the dropdown menu for Group and click “Logon”



3. You will be directed through authentication using your PennWest account.



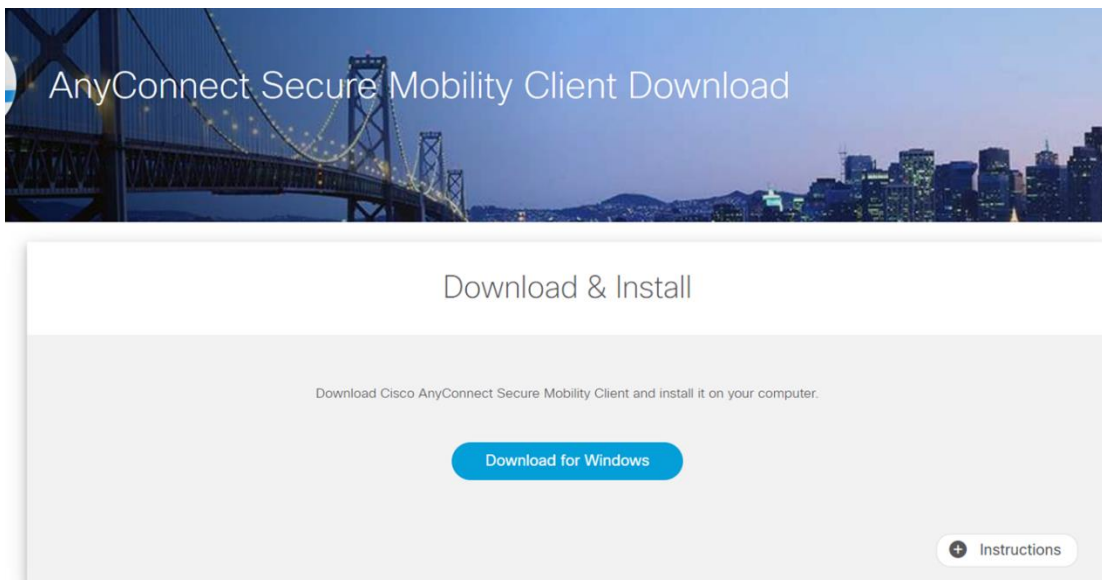

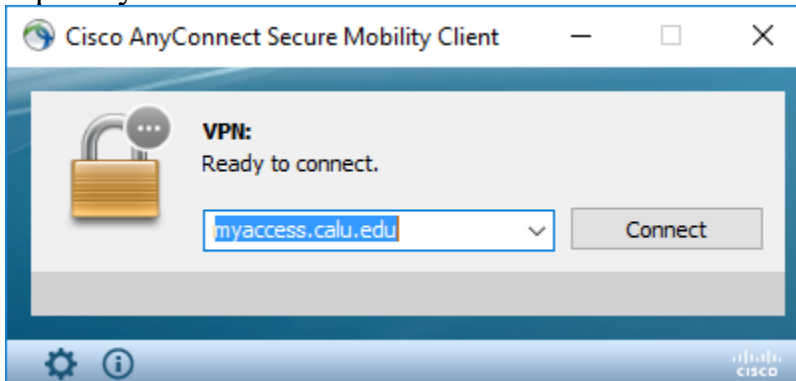

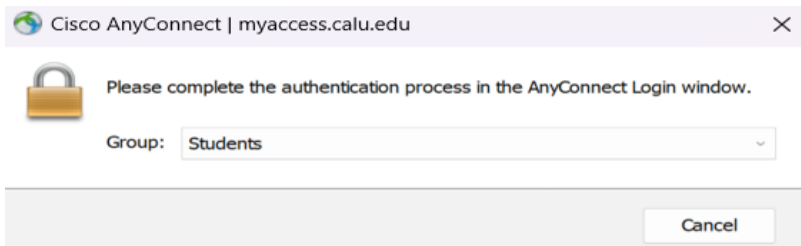
4. Download and install Cisco AnyConnect. Note this process may vary depending on your operating system.




5. Once installed, run the Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client from your start menu
6. Input myaccess.calu.edu into the box and click Connect



7. From the box that appears, select Student from the dropdown menu (this may go behind the logon screen)



8. Sign in using your Pennwest login and password
